RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Kalispel Business Committee is the duly Constituted governing body of the Kalispel Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws for the Kalispel Tribe; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Kalispel Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and all Reservation residents; and

WHEREAS, the Law and Order Code of the Kalispel Tribe of Indians (hereafter "Code") is the embodiment of Resolutions passed by the Kalispel Business Committee, for the purpose of protecting the lives, property, culture and natural resources of the Kalispel Tribe of Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Kalispel Assimilative Crimes Act was previously in Chapter 2 CRIMINAL PROCEDURES; and

WHEREAS, during the revision of Chapter 2, this Act was removed because it is more appropriately placed in Chapter 9 CRIMINAL OFFENSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kalispel Assimilative Crimes Act be incorporated into Chapter 9 CRIMINAL OFFENSES as new Section 9-8:


SECTION 9-8: ASSIMILATIVE CRIMES ACT

9-8.01 KALISPEL ASSIMILATIVE CRIMES ACT


Assimilative Crimes Act - Whoever within or upon any of the places now existing or hereafter reserved or acquired which are subject to the Kalispel Tribal Code, is guilty of any act or omission which, although not made punishable by any enactment of the Kalispel Business Committee, would be punishable if committed or omitted with the jurisdiction of the State of Washington by the laws thereof in force at the time of such act or omission, shall be guilty of a like offense and subject to a like punishment or such punishment which the Tribal Court finds is appropriate subject to the limitations that the punishment is not more than a fine of \$5,000.00 and/or jail time for a period greater than one year.

CERTIFICATION

The Kalispel Business Committee adopted the foregoing RESOLUTION at a meeting held on the 12 day of Jan., 2016, at the Tribal office on the Kalispel Indian Reservation near Usk, Washington, with the required quorum present by a vote of 3 FOR and 0 AGAINST.
