R E S O L U T I O N

- WHEREAS,** the Kalispel Business Committee is the duly constituted governing body by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Kalispel Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Kalispel Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and all reservation residents; and
- WHEREAS,** the Kalispel Law and Order Code (KLOC), Chapter 2 provides for procedures for a criminal case in Tribal Court, including the procedures and rights for defendants. The KLOC under Chapter 2 however does not address procedures and rights for the victims in criminal cases; and
- WHEREAS,** Kalispel Tribal and Community Members have raised concerns about the Kalispel Law and Order Code not having any provisions in the KLOC to protect the victim or the victim's rights; and
- WHEREAS,** It is in the best interest of the Tribe and the Community that the rules governing the operation of criminal procedure incorporate protection for the victims of a crime and should be codified into the Tribe's Law and Order Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that effective immediately the Kalispel Tribe Business Committee adopts the proposed Chapter 2A Crime Victim Rights Act into the Kalispel Law and Order Code.

C E R T I F I C A T I O N

The foregoing RESOLUTION was adopted by the Kalispel Tribal Council at a meeting held on the 13 day of December, 2016, at the Tribal Office on the Kalispel Reservation with the required quorum present by a vote of 3 FOR and 0 AGAINST.
